#	Question	Answer(s)
1	What is LTI?	Hi Mzilikazi. LTI is short for Learning Tools Interoperability. It is the technology that allows external tools to integrate within Canvas.
2	Is it obvious on Canvas if my college has this feature?	Hi Tami, Usually the Canvas administrator will make it available on your campus instance of Canvas, although sometimes they hide it so that is up to their discretion, although we recommend that they make it visible.
3	Can videos uploaded to 3C media also be used in the Blackboard interface?	Yes, we do offer a "share" link that can be used in Blackboard though the instructor would need to add those links into their Blackboard course individually. We are not currently offering LTI support for Blackboard.
4	Does the video need to be captioned?	Hi Masoumeh. Yes, instructional videos do need to be captioned UNLESS you are only using a video for a single class term *and* none of your students require captioning as an accommodation. (Example: An intro video that you won't use again next semester.) But captions help everyone and they are always a best practice.
5	Why would an instructor want to hide the 3C media from the navigator	Linda, one reason might be because instructors want to ensure students view the videos within the content they've designed in their modules and assignments.
6	Mirla, if I don't see the 3C Media icon on my assignment editing function, what may be the problem? I do see it on my settings navigation.	live answered

The Canvas LTI mirrors what is in the 3C account, so you would need to do your organizing within the 3C Media website."
